Catholic Schools Week:

Wednesday of Catholic Schools Week is National Appreciation Day for Catholic Schools. At local, state, and national levels, Catholic students, families, and educators reach out to community and government leaders. They share information about the significant contributions Catholic schools make to the nation and their role in preparing students to be good citizens.

In 2011, several members of the U.S. House of Representatives cosponsored House Resolution 61, supporting the contributions of Catholic schools. The resolution recognizes Catholic schools for instilling “broad, values-added education emphasizing the lifelong development of moral, intellectual, physical, and social values in young people in the United States.” It calls on the House of Representatives to support “the continued dedication of Catholic schools, students, parents, and teachers across the United States toward academic excellence” and “the key role they play in promoting and ensuring a brighter, stronger future for the nation.”
