Re: Sweatshirt Policy for 2009-2010 school year

Please be advised of the new policy for outer garments beginning with the 2009 – 2010 school year.

From the time a student arrives on campus until the bell for dismissal, only the official Vandebilt navy sweater, *navy sweatshirt/hoodie* (purchased through the Terrier Club), lettermen jacket, or a solid navy coat with no logos are permitted.

The style of the new navy sweatshirt, to be sold by the Terrier Club, will be the same as the current navy hoodie (except it will not have a hood or a pocket). The navy hoodie will be phased-out. The Terrier Club will be allowed to sell the remainder of the navy hoodies they have in stock; however, no additional hoodies may be purchased by the Terrier Club to sell to the student body.

We believe this greatly simplifies the policy and will make it easier for all school personnel to enforce.

The policy does not allow for any team, club, band, or other organization's apparel to be worn except on official school dress down days and after dismissal. Coaches, moderators, and directors please keep this in mind if you are considering selling sweatshirts/hoodies to the student body as a fund raiser.
